01 Integrate $1/((x+1)(x+2)) \, dx$.

02 Integrate $(3x+5)/((x+1)(x+2)) \, dx$.

03 Integrate $1/(x^2-1) \, dx$.

04 Integrate $(x^2+1)/x \, dx$ for $x \neq 0$.

Worked answers | Lesson 327

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01 Integrate $1/((x+1)(x+2)) \, dx$.

Decompose into $1/(x+1)-1/(x+2)$. Result $\ln|x+1|-\ln|x+2|+C$ on intervals avoiding $-1,-2$.

02 Integrate $(3x+5)/((x+1)(x+2)) \, dx$.

Decomposition $2/(x+1)+1/(x+2)$ gives $2\ln|x+1|+\ln|x+2|+C$.

03 Integrate $1/(x^2-1) \, dx$.

Decomposition $(1/2)/(x-1)-(1/2)/(x+1)$. Result $(1/2)\ln|(x-1)/(x+1)|+C$.

04 Integrate $(x^2+1)/x \, dx$ for $x \neq 0$.

Divide first: $x+1/x$. Integral $x^2/2+\ln|x|+C$.
